Feature	Description
Accessible Anywhere	Web application allows registered users to access eBehavior CMS from any computer without installing any software.
Discipline Event Types	eBehavior supports praises, detentions, and referral event types. The types of events are configurable by the individual school. Some examples of praises include "Did Well on Test", or "On-Task" whereas discipline events might include "Tardy", or "Academic Dishonesty"
Praise Monitor	Every user of eBehavior CMS can see his or her daily and yearly ratio of praises to detentions assigned as well as the school's overall ratio; this supports each individual to work together to realize the school's vision for a positive learning environment.
Detention Events	Students receiving a detention event are automatically assigned a 1-day detention. An event that has been flagged as a referral can have the detention quantity changed in the Referral Manager (see below).
Class Rosters	Teachers can quickly find their students by selecting their class and then one or more students. eBehavior can integrate with your school's information system so that your teachers see accurate and up-to-date class rosters.
Automatic Parent Notification	Parents can receive an email or text message when their student receives a praise, detention, or referral. Emails contain the details of the event, the date, and the teacher involved; text messages provide an overview.
Parent/Student Portal	Parents and students can stay up-to-date with student progress by logging into the secure eBehavior Portal. The Portal provides parents with the ability to register one or more students (from one or more schools) and monitor their performance. It also provides a dashboard view to look at overall performance as well as detailed eBehavior reports.
Detention Manager	eBehavior CMS allows designated users to track and manage detentions. Those with appropriate privileges (such as the teacher, dean or campus aides) use this feature to clear detentions as they are served.
Referral Manager	Similar to the Detention Manager described above, Referral Manager allows the dean (and whoever else has privileges) to manage referrals. This includes the ability to adjust detention quantity, enter notes, and document other responses, such as parent conference, etc.
Reports	<p>eBehavior provides a powerful set of reports that may be generated by teachers and administrators.
