

LIVE Online Math (www.liveonlinemath.com) is seeking a part-time math teacher for the 2016-2017 school year and beyond to teach <u>Classes</u> and/or <u>Video-Plus Courses</u> (VPCs). Work will be done at home using your own computer hardware, internet connection, etc.

A new teacher would begin as a tutor during the 2015-2016 school year and would also do some 2016 summer programs in order to become familiar with the online format, user interface, etc.

## **Position Details for Classes**

- Classes meet 3x each week for 1 hr.
- Scheduling is flexible; specific class schedule will be determined in consult with candidates
- All classes are already fully made. Minimal lesson planning and other prep is required.
- Est. Weekly Work Time Per Class: 5-6 hrs. (includes session time, prep, correcting, etc.)
- Formal parent / parent/teacher conferences will be offered twice per school year.
- Class(es) to be taught will be primarily determined by student enrollment.
- Pay: \$3,500-\$5,000 per class per yr. DOE

## **Position Details for Video-Plus Courses**

- VPCs meet one time per week for 1 hr.
- Scheduling is flexible; specific weekly schedule will be determined in consult with candidates
- All courses are already **fully made**. Minimal lesson planning and other prep is required.
- Est. Weekly Work Time Per Course: 2-3 hrs. (includes session time, prep, correcting, etc.)
- Course(es) to be taught will be primarily determined by student enrollment.
- Pay: \$1,200-\$1,700 per course per yr. DOE

## Candidates must...

- Be an experienced math teacher/tutor (traditional teaching, online, in-person tutoring, etc.).
- Be an excellent teacher and be competent through Algebra II.
- · Pass a background check.
- Be able to work in a physical space that is not noisy and has an aesthetically pleasing background for being on webcam.
- Quickly develop rapport/relationship with students via the synchronous online format.
- Have an engaging/fun/humorous personality and teaching style.
- Have the necessary equipment in order to be an effective synchronous online teacher (high speed internet, headset, webcam, etc.).
- Have a moderate level of general technological skill.

## Preference will be given to...

- Experienced synchronous online teachers. Particular preference will be given to teachers who
  are proficient with using Blackboard Collaborate (formerly Elluminate).
- Candidates presently using Blackboard Collaborate or some other synchronous learning platform where their teaching style and skills may be observed.
- State certificated math teachers.
- Candidates with web programming experience (HTML, CSS, PHP, etc.).
