


Humanities

- Means different things to different people.
- Overall Concept:
 - To include a variety of subjects
 - Incorporate those subjects to fit together
 - Relate to the human environment
 - Diverse Heritage
 - Traditions
 - Human History



Humanities

- Cross Curriculum
 - Choosing a Modernism Artist
 - Subjects Covered
 - History (Art from 1860-1970)
 - Literature (Research)
 - Technology (Designing the magazine)
 - Art (Exploring Artist)



Instructional Strategy

■ 6 C's

- Choice
 - Allowing them to choose their own artist.
 - Create their own design for magazine.
- Challenge
 - Discovering which artist relates to them.
 - Designing a magazine cover.
- Control
 - Doing their own research.
 - Controlling the design of their own project
- Constructing Meaning
 - Develop a better understanding of Modern Artist

 - Visual and Kinestic




Pigaet

- Creating a project based on their knowledge



Connecting Humanities to Classroom Instruction

Using the two Main Content areas

Art
Technology
Other subjects
History
Literature

Incorporating techniques from a variety of content areas to teach and then allow the students to create one project.





Planning/Researching for the Project

- Allow the students to choose an artistic from a list of modern artist.
- Develop a check list of Items that must be included on the final project.
- Explain different ways of researching artist.
- Explaining an artistic view on a layout.

Creating the Magazine Cover

- Teaching the students
 - The steps how to use Microsoft Publisher to Create a Magazine Cover.
 - Different graphical effects that can enhance the appearance.
- Instructional Strategies
 - Students will work at own computers.
