

- The Problems:

 - Allows academics, students and professionals to send and store information in their web-based Personal Knowledge Vault, share it within their knowledge network and showcase their Knowledge Profile on the Web

Bibkosh -Knowledge Networking Re-defined

Capture and Store Knowledge in your Personal Knowledge Vault

- Send URLs and snippets of information from web pages
- Upload documents
- Forward important emails

Categorize your Knowledge and Read Online

- Automatic semantic classification of Knowledge Objects into relevant Themes
- Organize your Knowledge Vault by creating Themes
- Launch your Knowledge Objects and read online.


Collaborate and Share

- Create groups and collaborate on common projects.
